

## Friday PM Excursion

After a quick lunch we rent a flash E-bike from the local bike manufacture «Tour de Suisse» and cycle comfortably and effortlessly westwards along the Lower Lake part of Lake Constance (Untersee) to Mannenbach (ca. 10km, all flat on cycle paths along the lake). If you don't feel like cycling (or the weather is really bad...), there will be also the option of taking the train there and also back (sadly, boats only run once a day from October onwards and hence this is not an alternative...).

After reaching Mannenbach-Salenstein, we will visit Arenenberg castle, the childhood home of Napoleon III, the last Emperor of France which thrones above the village. Apart from taking in the spectacular views over Lake Constance we will get a guided tour through the tastefully furnished interior of the castle.

We will then cycle back and stop in the picturesque and romantic village of Gottlieben where the famous Gottlieber wafer rolls, a famous Swiss delicacy, originate from. Of course you can taste them there in the company's local café along with a cup of coffee.

Costs: 25 CHF for E-bike rental inclusive helmet (to be paid on the day)
