

Saturday Hiking Excursion to the Alpstein region in the canton of Appenzell

The canton of Appenzell comes probably very close to the picture postcard Switzerland you might have in mind. Rolling green hills dotted with lakes and cows juxtaposed against rugged grey cliffs reaching up to a (hopefully!!) blue autumn sky...

We would like to invite you to a small but beautiful hike up to the mountain lake «Seealpsee» in the Alpstein region. The hike is not very long, however, will require you to walk about an hour uphill on a forest trail in order to reach the picturesque valley in which this famous lake is located. After a good rest and an optional lunch in the mountain inn and/or walk around the lake we will go back down on a service road (faster...) and take those of you to the train station in Appenzell who need to fly out on Saturday evening.

The train leaves at 14.30h from there and should get you into Zurich airport at 16:06.

Of course, we recommend you to stay on until Sunday and travel back to Kreuzlingen with us. This would allow you to also visit the pretty village of «Appenzell» with its unique local architecture and/or a cheese dairy if participants would like to do so after the hike.

Costs: 20 CHF for transport by mini-bus/car
